SC Refuses to Stay Ongoing Dharavi Redevelopment Project Construction

New Delhi: The Supreme Court Friday refused to stay the ongoing construction work for Mumbai's Dharavi Redevelopment Project, billed as Asia's largest urban rehabilitation initiative that seeks to rebuild a vast area adjacent the bustling financial district of India's commercial capital. The project was awarded to an Adani group company in 2022 by Mantralava.

A bench, led by Chief Justice of Sanjiv Khanna, issued a notice to Adani Properties, the state government and others on an appeal by the Seclink Technology Corporation (STC), which had challenged the Bombay High Court's December order that upheld the state government's decision to issue a fresh tender to the Adani Group in 2022.

A 2019 bid, won by STC, for the development of Mumbai's Dharavi slum was cancelled in favour of the 2022 tender

The HC had refused to intervene and had rejected STC's plea that the tender conditions were tailor-made to suit a particular bidder, a decision that the Dubai firm termed as "blatant abuse of power".

Senior counsel CA Sundaram, appearing for STC, undertook before the SC that the company was ready to increase its original bid of ₹7,200 crore by 20% to ₹8,640 crore. While the CJI noted the STC's offer of ₹8,640 crore was substantially higher than Adani's ₹5,069 crore, he asked the Dubai firm to file an affidavit to this effect.

However, the apex court clarified that STC's bid excluded all obligations which Adani Properties had agreed to take, which was upfront payment of ₹1,000 crore toward lease to the Railways, an indemnity amount of ₹2,800 crore, and construction of 812 railway quarters.

STC has undertaken to fulfil all other obligations under the tender for the 259-hectare Dharavi redevelopment project, the top court said.

Since the matter is in court, and the construction and demolition work had already started, Adani has been asked to maintain a separate bank account where all credits and disbursements will be made for the purpose of execution of the project.

"Proper accounts including invoices, etc as required by the Income Tax Act and Rules shall be undertaken," the SC said, stressing that "no special equities will be claimed by either side" and the contract would be subject to the outcome of the appeal.

Sundaram further said that the HC order erroneously upheld the "arbit-rary cancellation" of its tender, despite the UAE firm being the highest qualified bidder for the Dharavi Re-development Project. "The said order fails to appreciate the manifest illegality, procedural impropriety, and mala fide intent behind the cancellation. The petitioner submits that the decision of the respondents to cancel the earlier tender and issue a fresh one with altered conditions was taken with ulterior motives to favour a specific entity, violating the fundamental principles of transparency, fairness, and non-arbitrariness enshrined under Article 14 of the Constitution," the appeal stated. The top court said that there were two issues that arose in the case-cancellation of the original contract and tweaking of tender conditions to disable STC from submitting its tender despite it offering more than Adani firm.

While posting the matter for further hearing on May 25, the apex court said it prima facie agreed with the HC on the first issue since that latter had realised that the railway line would also be developed and should be included in the second tender.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta represented the Maharashtra government and senior counsel Mukul Rohatgi appeared for Adani.



SC refuses to halt Dharavi Redevelopment Project

he Supreme Court (SC) on Friday sought responses from the Maharashtra government and Adani Properties on a plea challenging the award of the Dharavi slums redevelopment project to Adani.

The apex court, however, refused to halt the ongoing work at the project site after Adani Group said that the construction had already started and over 2,000 workers were involved in it. They also told the court that they had invested funds, procured construction equipment worth crores of rupees, and started the demolition of railway quarters on the site.

The plea, filed by a UAE-based firm SecLink Technologies, challenged the state government's decision to cancel SecLink's 2019 bid for the redevelopment of Dharavi slums and awarding the tender to Adani in 2022. SecLink Technologies Corporation (STC) is a UAE-based real estate and construction company.

After STC offered to improve its offer of ₹72,000 crore by 20 per cent, a Bench of Chief Justice of India Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Sanjay Kumar asked the company to file an affidavit stating this and scheduled the hearing for May 25. The court also said the project awarded to the Adani Group is 'subject to court orders'.

The SC told Adani Group to channel all project-related payments through a single escrow account, with proper documentation, and to route all financial transactions related to the project through the designated account.

In December 2024, the Bombay High Court had dismissed the petition filed by the UAE-based firm, saying that it 'lacked force'. In November 2018, the Dharavi Redevelopment Project (DRP) tender was issued by the Maharashtra government, then headed by Devendra Fadnavis. A year later, the state government signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with the Indian Railways for the inclusion of 45 acres of Mahim-Matunga railway land.

In March 2019, the chief executive officer (CEO) of DRP under the Slum plea for making APPL a party to its petition. Rehabilitation Authority (DRP/SRA) wrote a letter to the Seclink consortium stating



that they are the preferred bidder in the case. In June 2019, the state sought the Advocate General's (AG) opinion on whether the inclusion of railway land constitutes a material change to the tender conditions or not. Responding to the query, Maharashtra's AG Ashutosh Kumbhkoni had then said that the inclusion of railway land constitutes a material change in tender conditions and therefore there was a need to go for fresh bids.

In October 2022, HC accepted Seclink's After the Bombay High Court dismissed STC's plea, it approached SC.

Court to assess Seclink's claim, seeks Maharashtra, Adani Group's replies

he Supreme Court on Friday refused to grant an interim stay on the Dharavi Slum Rehabilitation project being carried out by the Adani Group, during the hearing of a plea by Dubai-based Seclink Technology Corp, which had contested the contract award.

However, a bench led by Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna has agreed to examine the petition and issued notices to the Maharashtra government and the Adani Group.

The top court refused to halt the ongoing work at the project site after senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi, representing the Adani Group, said that the construction had already started. He said that Adani had employed over 2,000 workers, invested significant funds, procured construction equipment worth crores of rupees, and had initiated the demolition of railway quarters on the site.

The court directed the Adani Group to channel all project-related payments via a single escrow account, with proper documentation, including invoices and brochures. Any financial transactions related to the project must be routed through this designated account.

Senior advocate C. Aryama Sundaram, who represented Seclink, argued that the company was willing to increase its bid by 20%, proposing a revised bid of ₹8,640 crore far higher than Adani's base bid of ₹5,069 crore. He high-

lighted that Seclink's \$8,640 crore bid excluded an upfront payment of \$1,000 crore to the Indian Railways and an indemnity amount of \$2,800 crore. This, according to Seclink, made its overall financial commitment greater than the



Adani Group said construction was already underway, with significant investments in equipment and manpower for Dharavi's redevelopment.

Adani Group's total bid of ₹8,869 crore.

The Supreme Court directed Seclink to submit an official undertaking through an affidavit confirming its most recent financial offer. The case will be heard next in May, when the court is likely to examine the bid proposed by Seclink.

SC refuses status quo on Dharavi redevelopment

THE SUPREME COURT on Friday refused to order a status quo on the Dharavi redevelopment project in Mumbai.

A bench of Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Sanjay Kumar sought responses from the Maharashtra government and Adani Properties, which was awarded the tender for the project, on a petition challenging a December 20, 2024 verdict of the Bombay High Court.

The high court had cleared the decks for redevelopment of the slums in Dharavi and upheld the tender awarded to the Adani Group for the project, ruling there was no "arbitrariness, unreasonableness or perversity" in the decision.

The court, in the process, dismissed the plea of UAE-based Seclink Technologies Corporation challenging the state government's decision to award the mega redevelopment project to Adani Properties, which had made a ₹5,069-crore offer.

Seclink Technologies Corporation emerged as the highest bidder for the project first in 2018 with its ₹7,200-crore offer, but the tender was later scrapped by the government.

The Adani Group had emerged as the highest bidder for the 259-hectare Dharavi redevelopment project in the heart of Mumbai and bagged it with its ₹5,069-crore offer in 2022.

CLEARING THE DECKS

The corporation moved against the high court decision.

While issuing notice on its plea, the bench directed Adani Properties to make payments for the project through a single bank account.

After the bench issued notice on the plea, senior advocate C Aryama Sundaram appearing for Seclink Technologies Corporation urged the court to order a status quo.

The CJI, however, said, "No." Sundaram informed the bench that the petitioner company offered ₹7,200 crore in the first tender.

"I will increase my offer of ₹7,200 crore by 20%," he told the bench, adding that the figure comes to ₹8,640 crore.

"What about additional obligations?" asked solicitor general Tushar Mehta, appearing for the state.

When the bench asked Sundaram, if it was willing to increase the offer "with the same obligations as put on the highest bidder", Sundaram said "yes".

The bench noted Sundaram's submission on the proposed commitment and said, "The petitioner will file an affidavit to the said effect before this court." The matter would come in the week of May 25.

The bench, however, clarified no special equities would be claimed by either sides.

Senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi, appearing for Adani Properties, said the project work had already commenced.

"I have carried out constructions. I have deposited funds. About 2,000 people are employed," he said.

Mehta said some railway

quarters were demolished aside from new constructions taking place.

While dismissing Seclink Technologies Corporation's plea, the high court had also rejected its contention that the tenderwas "tailor made" to suit a particular firm of the private conglomerate, noting three bidders had participated in the process.

The government had cancelled the 2018 tender and issued a fresh one in 2022 with additional conditions.

The corporation first challenged the cancellation of the 2018 tender and subsequently the 2022 award of tender to the Adani Group.

The state government had claimed in the high court that the tender was awarded in a transparent manner without any undue favour to the highest bidder.

The government said the 2018 tender was cancelled and a fresh one was issued four years later owing to several factors like the COVID-19 pandemic and the Russia-Ukraine war which affected the financial and economic state of affairs.

The first tender for the mega redevelopment project was issued in November 2018.

In March 2019, the bids were opened and it was found that Seclink Technologies Corporation was the highest bidder.

A bench of Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Sanjiv Kumar declined a status quo order after it was informed that the work had already progressed.

Appearing for the Adani Group, Senior Advocate Mukul Rohatgi said machinery worth crores of rupees had been purchased and hundreds of workers had already started working at the site, including the demolition of an Indian Railways quarters on the site. The bench asked the Group to maintain an escrow account and ensure all project-related payments are channelled through this account and to main-

tain invoices and brochures.

Appearing for Seclink, Senior Advocate C Aryama Sundaram said the company was ready to increase its original bid of Rs 7,200 crore by 20 per cent, touching Rs 8,640 crore. The bench asked him to file an affidavit explaining this revised offer.

A Supreme Court bench comprising Chief Justice of India Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Sanjay Kumar rejected a plea on Friday (7 March), which had sought a stay on the Dharavi Slum Redevelopment Project, which is being executed by the Adani Group.

The petition for a stay was filed by the Dubai-based Seclink Technology Corporation (STC) which had challenged the Maharashtra government's decision to cancel its 2019 bid and award the project to Adani through a fresh tender process in 2022.

The Supreme Court refused to impose a status quo on the project, emphasising that construction had already commenced, but directed the Adani Group to



manage all financial transactions through an escrow account and maintain proper documentation.

Senior Advocate Mukul Rohatgi who appeared for the Adani Group told the Supreme Court that heavy machinery had already been deployed, with several hundred workers were actively engaged at the site, and demolition of certain structures, including an Indian Railways quarters, is already underway.

Senior Advocate CAryama Sundaram, appearing for STC, argued that the tendering process had been altered to favour Adani. He told the court that STC was prepared to increase its bid by 20 per cent, raising it to Rs 8,640 crore, surpassing Adani's winning bid. However, the court did not pass an immediate ruling on this proposal and instead instructed STC to submit an affidavit detailing the revised offer.

The dispute goes back to

2019, when STC had won the tender for the Dharavi Slum Redevelopment Project. Later, in 2022, the Maharashtra government annulled the previous process and invited fresh bids, which led to Adani Properties Private Ltd (APPL) emerging as the highest bidder with an offer of Rs 5,069 crore, excluding additional payments to the Indian Railways.

The formal contract was awarded in July 2023 and the Bombay High Court upheld this decision in December 2024, dismissing STC's challenge. However, STC petitioned the Supreme Court to stay the December 2024 Bombay High Court order, which was rejected by the apex court, giving 25 May 2025 as the next date of hearing.

The Adani Group's realty development company, Adani Properties, emerged as the highest bidder in November 2022, securing an 80 per cent stake in the Dharavi Redevelopment Project Pvt Ltd, with the Maharashtra government holding the remaining 20 per cent.

The slum rehabilitation project encompasses 600 acres of land near the Bandra Kurla Complex, with redevelopment planned for 296 acres, while preserving open spaces like the Mahim Nature Park.

Dharavi slum accommodates more than 850,000 residents, and when considering the transient population, this figure surpasses 1 million. With a huge population density of 354,167 per square kilometre, it is the most overcrowded zone in Mumbai, which itself ranks as the world's sixth most densely populated in the world.

NEW DELHI: The Supreme Court on Friday declined to halt the Dharavi redevelopment project, allowing work to proceed as it sought responses from the Maharashtra government and Adani Properties Pvt Ltd on a petition challenging the Bombay High Court's verdict upholding the project's tender process.

A bench comprising Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Sanjay Kumar issued notices to the state government and Adani Properties Pvt Ltd while considering a plea by UAE-based Seclink Technologies Corporation. The petitioner challenged the December 20, 2024, decision of the Bombay High Court, which dismissed its objections and ruled that the tender awarded to the Adani Group was free from "arbitrariness, unreasonableness, or perversity."

Senior advocate C Aryama Sundaram, representing Seclink Technologies Corporation, urged the top court to order a status quo on the redevelopment project. However, Chief Justice Khanna simply responded, "No."

Sundaram argued that his client had initially emerged as the highest bidder in 2018 with a Rs 7,200 crore offer, but the Maharashtra government had scrapped the tender before issuing a fresh one in 2022, in which Adani Properties Pvt Ltd secured the contract with a Rs 5,069 crore bid. Sundaram further submitted, "I will increase my offer of Rs 7,200 crore by 20 percent, bringing it to Rs 8,640 crore."

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Maharashtra government, asked, "What about additional obligations?" The court then inquired whether Seclink Technologies Corporation was willing to comply with the same conditions imposed on Adani Properties Pvt Ltd, to which Sundaram replied affirmatively.

The bench noted the petitioner's commitment and directed it to submit an affidavit confirming the same. The matter is scheduled for hearing in the week of May 25, with the court making it clear that "no special equities would be claimed by either side."

Senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi, representing Adani Properties Pvt Ltd, informed the court that work on the project was already underway. "I have carried out constructions. I have deposited funds. About 2,000 people are employed," he stated.

Mehta added that railway quarters had been demolished and new constructions had begun as part of the redevelopment efforts.

Seclink Technologies Corporation has repeatedly contested the state government's handling of the tender. It initially challenged the cancellation of the 2018 tender and later opposed the awarding of the 2022 tender to Adani Properties Pvt Ltd. The Bombay High Court had rejected Seclink's contention that the tender was "tailor-made" for a particular firm, noting that three bidders had participated in the process.

The Maharashtra government had defended its decision, asserting that the 2018 tender was scrapped due to multiple factors, including the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and the Russia-Ukraine war on economic conditions. It further stated that the fresh tender process in 2022 was conducted transparently without any undue advantage to a particular bidder.

Dharavi, one of the most densely populated slums in the world, is spread over 259 hectares and comprises a mix of residential and small industrial units. The redevelopment project aims to transform the area into a modern urban space with improved infrastructure and living conditions.

He said that Adani had employed over 2,000 workers, invested significant funds, procured construction equipment worth crores of rupees, and initiated the demolition of railway quarters on the site.

Senior advocate C Aryama Sundaram, representing Seclink, argued that the company was willing to increase its bid by 20%, proposing a revised bid of Rs 8,640 crore—substantially higher than Adani's base bid of Rs 5,069 crore. He highlighted that Seclink's Rs 8,640 crore bid excluded an upfront payment of Rs 1,000 crore to the Indian Railways and an indemnity amount of Rs 2,800 crore. This, according to Seclink, made its overall financial commitment greater than Adani's total bid of Rs 8,869 crore. The Supreme Court directed Seclink to submit an official undertaking through an affidavit confirming its latest financial offer. The case will be heard next in May, when the court is likely to examine the latest bid offer proposed by Seclink.

Upholds Bombay HC decision amid bid dispute by UAE-based firm

The Supreme Court on Friday refused to halt the ongoing construction of the Dharavi Redevelopment Project (DRP), upholding the Bombay High Court's decision in favour of the Adani

A bench comprising Chief Justice of India Sanjiv Khanna and Justice Sanjay Kumar, however, issued a notice to the Maharashtra government and Adani Properties on a plea by Dubai-based Seclink Technology Corporation.

The UAE-based firm challenged the Maharashtra government's decision to cancel its 2019 bid for the Dharavi redevelopment and issue a fresh tender in 2022, awarding the project to Adani.

The SC, however, decided to

consider the plea after Seclink offered to increase its bid by 20%.

Senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi, representing the Adani Group, contended before the bench that construction had already started. He said that the group had employed thousands of workers, invested substantial funds and procured construction equipment worth crores.

The SC was informed that the demolition of railway quarters at the site had commenced. The court then made it clear that it would not halt the work and directed the Adani Group to maintain an escrow account for all payments.

सुप्रीम कोर्ट ने शुक्रवार को धारावी पुनर्विकास परियोजना पर रोक लगाने से इनकार कर दिया। साथ ही बंबई हाईकोर्ट के फैसले पर भी रोक लगाने से मना कर दिया। प्रधान न्यायाधीश संजीव खन्ना और न्यायमूर्ति संजय कुमार की पीठ ने बंबई उच्च न्यायालय के 20 दिसंबर, 2024 के फैसले को चुनौती देने वाली याचिका पर महाराष्ट्र सरकार और अडाणी प्रापर्टीज प्राइवेट लिमिटेड से जवाब मांगा। अगली सुनवाई मई में होगी।





सुप्रीम कोर्ट का धारावी प्रोजेक्ट पर रोक से इनकार

सुप्रीम कोर्ट ने शुक्रवार को धारावी रिडेवलेपमेंट प्रोजेक्ट (डीआरपी) के लिए चल रहे निर्माण कार्य पर रोक लगाने से इनकार कर दिया। साथ ही बॉम्बे हाईकोर्ट के अडाणी ग्रुप के पक्ष में दिए फैसले को पलटने से भी इनकार कर दिया।
