'Double standards': Row over CM's Adani meeting

RANCHI: The meeting between businessman Gautam Adani and Jharkhand chief minister Hemant Soren sparked a war of words between the ruling alliance and the Opposition in the state on Friday, with the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) accusing the ruling allies of "double standards", even as the ruling Jharkhand Mukti Morcha (JMM) and the Congress backed the development, saying investment for economic growth and development is welcome.

Adani Group chairman Gautam Adani and his younger brother Rajesh Adani called on Soren at the latter's official residence in Ranchi late Thursday evening. Adani's maiden visit to the state was kept low-key, with both sides remaining tightlipped about the agenda discussed during the approximately three-hour-long high-profile meeting. The information & public relations department issued a picture and a short video, underlining that it was a courtesy meeting "where issues related to investment in the state were discussed".

The meeting also holds significance as it comes barely 10 days after the state government decided to institute a committee headed by the chief secretary to review the alleged violations of the memorandum of understanding between the state government and the operational 1,600 MW Adani power plant in Godda, which is supplying

power to Bangladesh.

Accusing the INDIA bloc parties of practising "double standards", BJP spokesperson Pratul Shahdeo said, "We are not against the meeting, but this exposes hypocrisy of the INDIA bloc. On one hand, they keep abusing industrialists, including Adani, and yesterday they gave him a red-carpet welcome. Their leaders keep criticising Adani-Ambani and accuse them of running the country, yet now they are hosting them for dinner."

Congress and the JMM defended the development, saying any investment is welcome. "We are not against an individual but against their wrongdoings. Our chief minister attended the business summit hosted by West Bengal CM in Kolkata. There, the chief minister invited business houses to invest in the state. If investment happens in the state, driving its growth and creating jobs, it is welcome," said

Congress general secretary Rakesh Sinha.

JMM spokesperson Manoj Pandey said, "We criticise the policies of the BJP government for favouring a few corporates. We are not against any particular individual. If any industrialist invests in a way that benefits the state, we welcome it."

Meanwhile, officials close to the developments said Adani's visit was aimed at addressing some "bottlenecks" and exploring "future investments".

"There are certain issues related to the power purchase agreement of the operational power plant, wherein 25 per cent of the generated power is to be provided to government. Positive movement is also expected in getting the Gondulpara coal mining project in Hazaribag operational. The Group is also interested in opening a cement factory in Godda, and expanding units in Chaibasa and Sindri."

In the two-hour long meeting the proposed cement plant in Godda and the coal block Gondulpada in Badkagaon, Hazaribag were discussed. Sources said that a total of 513.18 hectares of land has been marked for the

Gondulpada coal block project located in Barkagaon of Hazaribagh district, out of which more than 200 hectares is forest land, for which compensation land is also to be given.

which compensation faint is also to be given.

According to sources, a request was made to the CM regarding other clearances of the coal block project.

A target has been set for coal excavation from Gondulpada in early 2026.

During the meeting the proposed cement plant in Godda was discussed in detail. Junchlands share of 400 MW power in exchange for the 1600 MW power being supplied to Bangladesh by the Godda power plant was also discussed. Adami said that he is ready to supply 400

MW power to Jharkhand from one of his other plants. Sources said that the Adani group has requested the Jharkhand government for assistance in obtaining

for assistance in obtaining necessary approvals, particularly for the denotification of around 25 hectares of land required for a cement plant. This land is part of a 225-facere parcel acquired under the Raghubar Das administration within a Special Economic Zone (SEZ).

Since SEZ land is designated for specific uses, Adami Power has applied for denotification through the SEZ Commissioner after receiving the state government's initial approval.

The cement plant is expected to benefit both the

At present, the 1,600 MW produces large amounts of fly ash, a byproduct of coal com-bustion that can cause severe pollution if not properly man-aged. By using this fly ash as a primary raw material for cement production, the new facility aims to significantly reduce environmental con-tamination.

reduce environmental con-tamination.

This sustainable initiative will not only cut down on industrial waste but also con-tribute to a cleaner and more environmentally friendly industrial ecosystem in the region. Instead of allowing fly ash to accumulate, repurpos-ing it for cement production will help lower air and soil

Jharkhand.

The proposed cement plant, with a production capacity of 4 million tonnes per annum (MTPA) and an estimated investment of Rs 1,200 crore, is expected to generate between 3,000 and 5,000 direct and indirect


5,000 direct and indirect jobs.
Additionally, it will sup-port Jharkhand's industrial-ization and infrastructure development, foster a circu-lar economy by recycling fly ash, and further strengthen India's energy cooperation with Bangladesh, as Adani Power continues supplying electricity across the border. This project marks Adani's expanding presence

in Jharkhand's industrial sec-tor, extending beyond power generation. However, despite its economic and are tor, extenumg beyond power generation. However, despite its economic and environmental benefits, the initiative has sparked political controversy, particularly within the Congress party, which is part of the ruling coalition led by Hemant Soren.


Some Congress leaders are wary of Soren's engagement with Adami, seeing it as conflicting with the party's national stance against large corporate expansions by congomerates like Adami.

A meeting between Soren and Adami has intensified speculation about a growing association, raising concerns that such ties could weaken Congress's hold within the state government.
