350 Sqft Home With 2 Toilets For Eligible Residents

Mumbai: CM Fadnavis approved the Dharavi redevelopment master plan, after a detailed presentation by SVR Srinivas, Dharavi Redevelopment Project CEO, Wednesday night and stressed that it should preserve the basic commercial identity of Dharavi and its original features.

"Everyone who is the original resident of this place should be given a house. Everyone should get justice... though criteria will be different," said Fadnavis, according to a press release.

Sources said the first tranche of slum rehabilitation buildings is being constructed on a 28-acre railway land at

Mahim. Each eligible household will be given a 350 sq ft home with two toilets. It means, it might be the end of the crowded public toilet blocks, which have been a common feature of Dharavi.

A detailed presentation on the Dharavi master plan was made by Dharavi Redevelopment Project CEO and chairman of Navbharat Mega Developers Pvt Ltd (NMDPL), SVR Srinivas, at Sahyadri state guest house. Dy CMEknath Shinde, who is also the urban development and housing minister, was present for the meeting.

Local body elections, including those for BMC, will be held later this year.

A press release stated that CM Devendra Fadnavis directed the Dharavi redevelopment to be done in an environmentally friendly manner, integrating its commercial sector. He said priority should be given to the rehabilitation of skilled artisans. "Everyone who is the original resident of this place should be given a house. Everyone in Dharavi should get justice in the rehabilitation project; everyone here will be eligible for this redevelopment project, though criteria will be different," said Fadnavis, as per the press release.

Fadnavis emphasised that the concept of Dharavi development project should be implemented by preserving the basic commercial identity of Dharavi and its original features. "For this, the relevant agencies should maintain the necessary coordina-

tion. Development works should be carried out in a coordinated manner by taking local people into confidence and preserving the public sentiment," he said.

Sources said the govt will decide on the publication of the Dharavi master plan. To make the project "viable", the govt has given a slew of incentives, including the waiver of all premiums besides reimbursement of the state's sha-

re of GST for five years. "In a normal slum rehab scheme, the developer has to pay 25% of the Ready Reckoner Rate as a premium for the plot. BMC owns nearly 60% of the land in Dharavi. Since all premiums have been waived for the project, BMC will not earn any revenue for its land," said sources.

The govt has also approved the mandatory first use of Dharavi TDR for all redevelopment projects in the city. TDR will not be marked as slum TDR; rather, it will be priced as per the plot on which it is used. This is likely to raise the cost of flats in

Mumbai. Further, BMC, in its objections/suggestions to the govt, said mandatory first use of Dharavi (40%) and Slum (20%) TDR will make it difficult to implement the Development Plan - 2034 in terms of acquisition of land for civic infrastructure and public amenities.

There has been opposition from several areas within Dharavi to the survey. One of the most well-known sectors, Kumbharwada, has opposed the survey. Congress MP Varsha Gaikwad termed it "the biggest real estate grab in history. A Vinash project to expand Adani's empire in the heart of Mumbai, displacing lakhs of people in the process". "The approval violates provisions of the MRTT, which states that any new draft master plan must be subject to public scrutiny," she said.

However, critics of the project said if the survey is not yet complete, how was the master plan prepared? What is the basis for its approval? How can land use planning be determined based on old surveys or incomplete information? Dharavi MLA Jyoti Gaikwad said "Without consultation, without a completed survey, and in total violation of legal process, the CM has approved Adani's so-called master plan for Dharavi; a plan not for development, but for displacement."

Govt approves Dharavi redevelopment master plan; Rs 95,790 crore project cost

THE MAHARASHTRA government on Wednesday approved the master plan for the Dharavi Redevelopment Project.

The approval was granted during a high-level review meeting chaired by Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis at the Sahyadri Guest House, where Chief Executive Officer of the project SVR Srinivas presented a detailed overview of the plan.

After the presentation, CM Fadnavis said that the project would be implemented through an environmentally sustainable and integrated approach. He emphasised that the rehabilitation

of local artisans and residents would be prioritised in the ambitious initiative.

According to officials, Fadnavis directed authorities to ensure that Dharavi's original identity as a vibrant economic and industrial hub is preserved.

"The core essence of Dharavi must be protected. We are not just building structures, we are rebuilding lives," Fadnavis said during the meeting.

"Every eligible resident must receive a home in Dharavi. Every skilled artisan and small business should be brought into the mainstream through fair rehabilitation. The criteria for eligibility may differ, but no one from Dharavi should be left behind," he added.

Deputy Chief Minister Eknath

Shinde, who was also present at the meeting, instructed the departments concerned to expedite all necessary approvals and processes related to the project. The Dharavi project is considered one of Asia's largest slum rehabilitation initiatives.

The redevelopment is being carried out by a special purpose vehicle (SPV) set up through a joint venture between the Maharashtra government's Slum Rehabilitation Authority (SRA) and the Adani Group's Dharavi Redevelopment Project Private Limited (DRPPL), now renamed Navbharat Mega Developers Private Limited (NMDPL).

In this SPV, Adani Properties Private Limited (APPL) holds an 80 per cent stake, while the re-

maining 20 per cent is held by the SRA. The gross area of the Dharavi Notified Area is approximately 253.7 hectares. Of this, the redevelopment project covers 173.90 hectares (usable area), including land under the Railway Land Development Authority (RLDA), while 79 hectares of property are excluded from the project scope.

The total estimated cost of the project is Rs 95,790 crore.

The project received official approval and the Letter of Acceptance (LoA) on July 17, 2023. Construction began on January 14, 2025, with the issuance of the First Commencement Certificate (First CC). The project is scheduled to be completed within seven years, by January 13, 2032.

CHIEF Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Wednesday gave his nod to the Dharavi Redevelopment Project (DRPL) master plan that aims to change one of Asia's largest slums into a modern, sustainable neighbourhood. The plan was presented to Fadnavis, Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde and senior IAS officials during a high-level meeting held at the Maharashtra government's Sahyadri Guest House at Malabar Hill. Fadnavis asserted that the redevelopment should be carried out in an environment-friendly and integrated manner. » **P07**

Preserve commercial identity of the area: Fadnavis

IN the meeting on Wednesday, Fadnavis instructed that redevelopment should be implemented while preserving the commercial identity of the area. "The agencies concerned should coordinate to ensure this key element is given priority during the development," the CM said.

Aware of the local and political opposition to the project, the CM emphasised on carrying out activities in a coordinated manner, while keeping public sentiment at the centre and local people in confidence. DyCM Eknath Shinde directed the departments concerned to promptly secure the necessary approvals for the project.

The move drew sharp criticism, with Congress MP Varsha Gaikwad saying the 'Adani Sarkar' has betrayed the residents of

Dharavi again. "Without any people consultation or adherence to due legal process, the chief minister approved the master plan for Dharavi despite widespread public unrest. This is not a master plan for development, but the blueprint for Adani's astronomical vikas (progress) at the cost of all those who built and nurtured Dharavi over generations. This isn't redevelopment — it is the biggest real estate grab in history. A vinash (destructive) project to expand Adani's empire in the heart of Mumbai, displacing lakhs of people in the process. The people of Dharavi have consistently and unequivocally opposed Adani's 'Dharavi vinash' plan."

According to Gaikwad, the question is, if the tenement survey is still ongoing, on what basis has this master plan been finalised and approved? "How can existing and proposed land use be determined based on old data or an incom-

plete survey? This approval also violates provisions of the MRTAP Act, which clearly state that any new draft master plan must be subjected to public scrutiny. It cannot be sanctioned without first inviting public suggestions, objections, and holding hearings. So, why has this critical process been bypassed? Why are laws repeatedly bent, twisted, and broken, always in favour of Adani?" she questioned. "The law exists for a reason. Follow it... Don't bulldoze it! Dharavi is not for sale!"

Dharavikars will continue to fight for their rights, and every

one of them must be rehabilitated within Dharavi itself."

While Shiv Sena (UBT) MP Anil Desai was not reachable, Baburao Mane, former Shiv Sena (undivided) MLA from Dharavi, said the plan has been designed keeping Adani centre stage and not the people of Dharavi. "Public suggestion and objection needs to be given a hearing. If this process is not followed, we will hit the streets to protest," Mane said. Mane, also a Dharavi Bachao Andolan leader, said that apart from street protests, the locals would even take the battle to court.

Meanwhile, Shiv Sena (UBT)

MP Sanjay Raut claimed that if the plan is approved without following due process of giving a public hearing, then it is clear indication of the government working to benefit their industrialist friend. "Without hearing the locals' suggestions and objections, how can the plan get a go-ahead. This is nothing but dictatorship and the cheating of people in Dharavi," Raut said.

On March 25, the state cabinet had given its nod to a proposal wherein ineligible tenants would not only will be given accommodation on a rental basis, but after 12 years, the tenement would be transferred in the name of the occupant.

Slums that came up prior to 2001 would get free houses and the ones that came up between 2001 and 2011 would pay construction cost rates. Tenements after 2011 are not eligible for the project.

The Dharavi Redevelopment Project (DRP) is estimated to cost over ₹200,000 crore and involves constructing 100 million square feet for rehabilitation. According to rough estimates, approximately 1.25 lakh tenements — both residential and commercial units — will need to be rehabilitated.

The revamp will be carried out by Navbharat Mega Developers Pvt Ltd (NMDPL) — a

joint venture between the Maharashtra government and the Adani Group. While the project involves construction of 100 million square feet for rehabilitation for which, NMDPL will have the rights to develop and sell 140 million square feet for free sale. The Adani Group holds 80 per cent stake in NMDPL and the balance is held by the state government.

CM Fadnavis directed the redevelopment be carried out in an environmentally sustainable and integrated manner, with a strong emphasis on preserving Dharavi's distinctive identity as a hub of micro-industries and a contributor to the city's economy.

Underlining the significance of the project, Fadnavis stated, "The core commercial fabric of Dharavi, known for its skilled artisans and diverse small-scale industries, must be safeguarded. The rehabilitation of local craftsmen and entrepreneurs should be prioritised. Every original resident of Dharavi must be provided a home under this redevelopment initiative." He emphasised that the eligibility criteria for rehabilitation must be inclusive and ensure that all genuine stakeholders benefit from the project. "While modern infrastructure is crucial, it must coexist with the traditional commercial character of Dharavi," he added.

Fadnavis urged departments to work in close coordination, conduct development with cultural sensitivity, and maintain ongoing consultation with local communities. Deputy CM Shinde instructed all departments to expedite approvals and streamline procedures to facilitate smooth and timely execution of the project.

Dharavi Redevelopment Project CEO Srinivas presented a comprehensive roadmap outlining the project's scope and implementation strategy during the meeting.
