Mumbai: The population of Dharavi will be 4.9 lakh after the implementation of the redevelopment plan, according to a presentation made to the CM this week. Given that current population estimates of the slum sprawl vary widely from 7 lakh to a million, the area is expected to see significant decongestion within a decade.

Providing a break-up to CM Fadnavis Wednesday, it was informed that the Rehab-Renewal population (slum dwellers and those living in authorised buildings) in Dharavi will be approximately 3 lakh after redevelopment. Around 1 lakh new residents are expected to move into sale buildings, while developed properties excluded from the revamp plan will add up to roughly 65,000-70,000. In

addition, the planners expect a natural population growth of roughly 16,000 over the next seven years while the project is being implemented.

The presentation was made by S V R Srinivas, CEO, Dharavi Redevelopment Project and chairman of Navbharat Mega Developers Pvt Ltd, the special purpose vehicle executing the project.

Congress MP Varsha Gaikwad, who was earlier MLA from Dharavi, said, "No elected representative was invited for the presentation. No resident either. Only Adani representatives were present. The survey is not complete, the annexure II which informs about eligibility is not ready, how did this meeting happen? People do not know where they will get homes. For whom is this project being implemented?"

Dharavi Plan Aims At 50k Hsg Units

Mumbai: Describing the redevelopment of Mumbai's biggest slum sprawl as a project for gentrification, the latest govt presentation on the plan envisages a "green spine" for the 2.6sqkm precinct along with a central park, waterfront and museum. A multi-modal transit hub and mixed-use neighbourhoods supporting traditional livelihoods of artisans and homes in high-rises are also part of the blueprint.

Five new entry points have been proposed linking Dharavi to Bandra-Kurla Complex, Sion and Mahim. Total rehab cost is estimated at Rs 95,790 crore, which involves construction of 49,832 residential rehab units and 8,700 residential renewal units, besides 12,458 commercial and industrial rehab units and 1,010 commercial renewal units. The sale component will be spread over 120 acres.

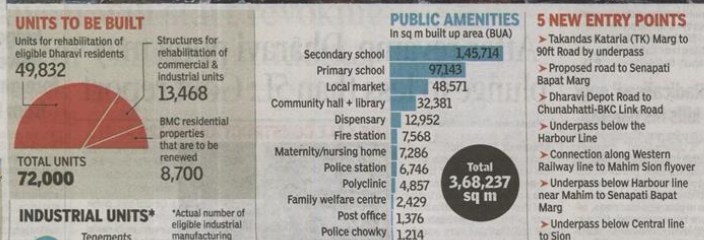
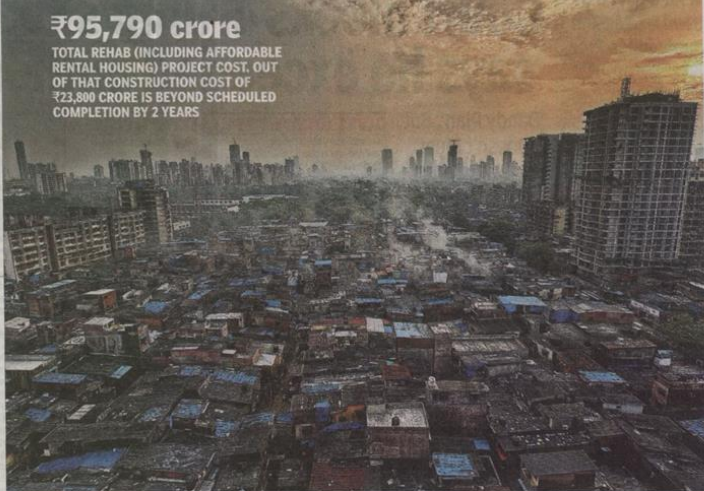
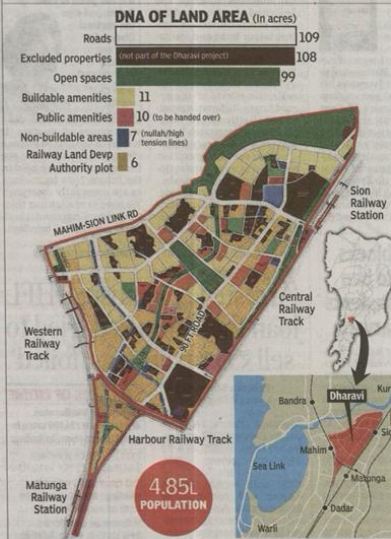
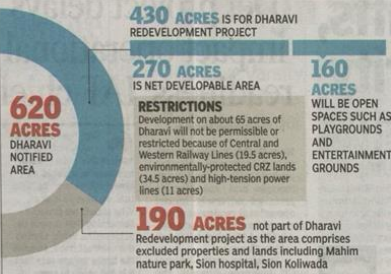
The presentation was made by S V R Srinivas, CEO, Dharavi Redevelopment Project and chairman of Navbharat Mega Developers, the special purpose vehicle executing the project, in the presence of the chief minister.

The plan marks a huge transformation for the Dharavi cluster which has existed for over a century. The history of the growth of slums here, as recorded in the city's Development Plan, says Dharavi was the home of the Koli fishers and the Mahim creek was their source of livelihood for centuries. Dharavi's rapid growth is intertwined with the patterns of migration into Bombay. The first to settle there did so because the land, mainly used as a rubbish dump, was free and unregulated. The marshy land slowly grew more solid but even till the mid-1900s, parts were so wet, people had to build footbridges to cross over. Pottery from Saurashtra were among the first to be relocated here and set up their colony (Kumbharwada), as also Muslim leather tanners from TN (because of the proximity of the abattoir in Bandra). Artisans and embroidery workers from UP started the readymade garments trade, and Tamilians set up a flourishing business, making savories and sweets.

The existing population now mostly comprises dwellers with basic structures that have mushroomed in low-lying creek land in an unplanned manner leading to problems such as poor accessibility. Most houses are serviced by narrow by-lanes of 2 to 3 feet width, while non-development of roads has hampered the work of providing sewer lines, states the report.

However, political representatives from the area say the revamp is a non-consultative process, controlled by the authorities in a manner that only strengthens business interests. Dharavi MLA Jyoti Gaikwad said the plan is "for Adani not for Dharavi's people"; else it would have been shared with the people before being finalised. Aditya Thackeray, Shiv Sena (UBT) leader, said, "who was the Mumbaikar present at the meeting where the plan was approved. If 50% of residents are being moved out then those who will be rehabilitated should get 500 sq feet homes."

Fears of displacement linked to community ties and a fading way of life

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Mumbai: Dharavi is not only a melting pot of various religions but of multiple cottage industries.

The settlement likely came up in 1884 when the British moved tanneries and "polluting units" outside the main city limits. Tamilians were the first to arrive here after the original Koli inhabitants and the potters of Kumbharwada. Today natives of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar form a sizable number too.

From leather to textiles, pottery to papads, trades are helmed by specific communities. Small home enterprises, many owned by women, roll out heaps of papads that are supplied to retail chains. Mysore Pak, a favourite South In-

dian sweet, is made and sold here as are bakery items and farasan. Men work as drivers for app cabs, or run shops or do menial labour.

Extended families stay in close proximity, having built

tall structures, sometimes circumventing the rules. The prospect of redevelopment does bring hope of better housing for those who will be rehabilitated there. However, others who fear displacement

cite not only loss of homes, but businesses and community ties. The loss of intangible heritage involves community shrines, schools, even Rajinikanth fan clubs whose members would wait for Thal-

var's film to release at Aurora Cinema, and arrive to perform milk abhishek on his giant posters.

"Dharavi's economy and society flourished with the arrival of Tamilians who built

temples, theatres, businesses. Although many families have now migrated northward to Chembur, Virar, Nallasopara, Kalyan-Dombivli, the community still dominates the area. Various Sanghams belonging to different sub sects celebrate festivals like Pongal, Ganeshotsav and Diwali," said M. Jesuraj, president in-charge of the DMK in Mumbai.

Maran Nayagam, general secretary of The Bombay South Indian Adi Dravid Mahajan Sangh, who was born and raised in Dharavi, cites a list of landmarks including a 150-year-old Ganesh temple whose existence is under threat. "Will it be preserved or rebuilt, and will its priests and caretakers be displaced or be able to continue worship?" Nayagam, who is chair-

man of an educational trust, says the local schools which provide cheap education to poor Tamil students are similarly sacred and valuable.

Rasheer Shaikh, secretary of a mosque, says Dharavi is a close knit community. "We all look out for each other. During the pandemic, our mosque and several other institutions and NGOs served food to hundreds of people. Nobody asked if you were Hindu or Muslim. We live like brothers, like a mini India."

Rev. Prabhu J, pastor of Good Shepherd Church which has about 5,800 subscribers, says, "People of all faiths live in peace because of interdependence. They live in very close proximity sharing common toilets and public spaces, living in narrow lanes where houses are set cheek by

jowl. We share food and sweets during festivals. People lived in mixed communities. And the diversity is not limited to religion but within the same religion also."

Indeed, there are Thevar and Nadar enclaves among Tamilians within Dharavi.

Rev Prabhu voices the fears of the flock. "Do you know, when Covid-19 struck, 20% of Dharavi's inhabitants were forced to return to their villages? They live in rented homes and were unable to pay rent. They live a frugal existence. Once redevelopment comes, they will shift to bigger spaces with better amenities, and outgoings and expenses will increase. Yet of course there is another segment which looks forward to bigger, better homes and improved quality of life."

Masterplan proposes 5-min access to essential amenities

Mumbai: The Dharavi Redevelopment plan proposes easy access to essential public amenities such as education, healthcare, retail markets and open spaces within 5, 10 and 15-minute walking distances.

Today a slum spread over 2.5 sq kms, the masterplan proposes that more than 80% of Dharavi will be within 5 minutes from a transit station, that more than 80% neighbourhoods will be within 5 minutes of a public open space, that more than 70%

neighbourhoods will be within a five-minute walk to social amenities.

In a presentation to chief minister Devendra Fadnavis on Wednesday, Dharavi Redevelopment Project CEO and chairman of Navbharat Mega Developers Pvt Ltd S V R Srinivas put forth a blueprint for a multi-modal transit hub with Metro Lines 3 and 11 passing through the area with strengthened pedestrian and vehicular connections from Dharavi to surrounding neighbourhoods.

Five new transit points are to be created connecting T K Marg to the arterial 90-feet road by an underpass; a new road is to be developed connecting to S B Marg; the Dharavi Depot road will connect to Chunabhatti-BKC Link road; another connector will come up along the Western Railway line to Mahim Sion flyover; an underpass below the Harbour line near Mahim will connect to S B Marg; and another underpass to Sion. A plan to redevelop Mahim and Sion rail-

way stations with concourse levels plus bus bays and taxi parking points was also presented. At Level one, it will bisect with Metro Line 11 extension and Metro Line 8 at Level 2.

Dharavi will also have its own museum to showcase its history, art and culture besides a working women's hostel, arbitration centre, convention and cultural centre, and medcity with wellness areas.

According to Dharavi's 2016 Develop-

ment Plan, there are 26 schools here which are run in temporary slum structures; only the Kamraj school in sector 3 is in a legal structure. "Students are crammed in small rooms with inadequate space and no playground facilities," states the report. The master plan proposes primary as well as secondary schools along with a community hall and library. A multi-speciality hospital will soon co-exist with an existing branch of the civic-run Sion hospital. —**Clara Lewis**

Dharavi master plan proposes 72,000 units for rehabilitation of tenants

AS MANY as 58,532 residential units and 13,468 commercial and industrial units will be constructed for the rehabilitation of eligible tenants within the existing Dharavi area, states the master plan of the Dharavi redevelopment project that was approved by the state government on Wednesday.

The numbers presented are part of the initial tenement estimates made by the special purpose vehicle that is undertaking the Dharavi redevelopment on the 251.24 hectares of Dharavi Notified Area.

While out of the 251.24 hectares area, 108.99 hectares of land has been deemed for redevelopment, the rest is reserved for infrastructure and public services in Dharavi.

The presentation of master plan given to the state government on Wednesday, a copy of which is with *The Indian Express*, states that out of the 108.99 hectares, rehabilitation of Dharavi's eligible residents will be carried out on around 56.01 per cent while 43.99 per cent will be for future commercial development and sale.

The Dharavi redevelopment is being carried out by Dharavi Redevelopment Project Private

Limited (DRPPL)— a special purpose vehicle that is a joint venture between the state government's Slum Rehabilitation Authority (SRA) and the Adani Properties Private Limited (APPL). The DRPPL is now called the Navbharat Mega Developers Private Limited (NMDPL), in which APPL holds 80 per cent stake while the remaining 20 per cent is with the SRA.

Messages sent to Adani Group spokesperson and NMDPL representative did not elicit any response.

Ever since bagging the project, the special purpose vehicle has been undertaking a survey to identify the total number of residents in Dharavi who are eligible for rehabilitation. It has, as per its master plan, estimated that it needs to construct 72,000 housing and commercial units on 47.20 hectares. According to the special purpose vehicle, only those who occupy ground floor structures will be eligible for rehabilitation.

However, this proposal has drawn criticism from residents of Dharavi, who are protesting against the project.

"In Dharavi, there are one lakh ground-floor structures, whose residents are eligible for rehabilitation. Apart from that, there are at least 1.5-2 lakh tenants who reside on the second and third floors. If only 72,000 units are there for eligible tenants, are they going to declare the remaining tenants ineligible for rehabilitation? Is their survey accurate? Have they completed the survey?," said Rajendra Korde, president of Dharavi Redevelopment Samiti.

According to official estimates, a total of 72,000 tenements will be constructed for rehabilitation, which includes 49,832 residential units for eligible slum dwellers, 8,700 renewal units for residents with valid tenure, 12,458 commercial/industrial units and 1,010 commercial renewal units.

According to the master plan, out of the total net usable area of 108.99 hectares available for development, 47.20 hectares is for rehabilitation of Dharavi tenants, 10.88 hectares for additional facilities such as museums, hostels and community halls, 2.96 hectares for utility and the remaining 47.95 hectares is land that will be developed for market sale by the SPV NMDPL.

The total estimated cost of the project is Rs 95,790 crore. Despite being a slum, Dharavi is considered to be a vital industrial zone, home to a variety of small to mid-scale sectors and forms an essential part of the city's export framework. The masterplan also envisions rehabilitation of the existing manufacturing and retail industries.

The masterplan states that a tentative clustering has been planned for the industries that are located in Dharavi. It has planned to make five industry clusters—garment, pottery, leather, food and recycling, all of which will be in the redeveloped area.

The master plan also proposes improving connectivity to Dharavi by creating five new entry points to the region by constructing underpasses and road extensions. As per the masterplan after the redevelopment, Dharavi will house around 4.95 lakh population.

Maharashtra approves Dharavi redevelopment master plan

The Maharashtra Government has approved the master plan for the Dharavi Redevelopment Project (DRP), aiming to transform Asia's largest slum while preserving its socio-cultural identity. Chaired by Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, the plan emphasises inclusive, eco-friendly development of 296 out of Dharavi's 620 acres. The project, executed by a Special Purpose Vehicle between the State and Adani-owned Navbharat Mega Developers, will rehabilitate 7 lakh residents and integrate residential, commercial, and industrial spaces. The redevelopment "seeks to balance progress with preservation," ensuring no resident is left behind.

The master plan of the Dharavi redevelopment project in Mumbai was approved on Wednesday.

The master plan was cleared at a meeting presided over by Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis.

"Dharavi's redevelopment will ensure that it does not lose its soul," Fadnavis said.

Deputy CM Eknath Shinde, who is the state's Urban Development Department Minister and the Guardian Minister of Mumbai City district, was also present besides DRP CEO SVR Srinivas.

Fadnavis said the govern-

ment has issued directions to all concerned departments with a strong emphasis on sensitive, inclusive, and eco-friendly redevelopment that preserves the identity of Dharavi.

"Dharavi is not just a locality. It represents a powerful micro-economy built on skilled labour, artisans, micro-enterprises, and underprivileged communities. It is essential that redevelopment efforts retain this spirit while unlocking new opportunities for the future," he said.

"We have issued clear directives to ensure the voices and aspirations of all citizens are integrated into the plan, maintain the socio-cultural identity of Dharavi throughout the

redevelopment, and enable a harmonious balance between progress and preservation," said the CM.

According to Fadnavis, the historic project is expected to accelerate with renewed momentum.

"Dharavi is a transformative economic zone capable of reshaping the nation's urban and economic landscape.

"The redevelopment must include every Dharavikar. Rehabilitation of local businesses must be done respectfully at their original locations, maintaining their traditional character. Trust-building, co-ordination, and empathy are essential components of process," he said.

उन्होंने तंज कसते हुए कहा कि अब हम यह नहीं चलने देंगे, क्योंकि मुंबई कोई सौदेबाजी की चीज नहीं है। उन्होंने यह भी आरोप लगाया कि गेटवे ऑफ इंडिया के पास प्रस्तावित जेटी किसी बड़े कॉन्ट्रैक्टर मित्र के लिए बनाई जा रही है। साथ ही चेतावनी दी कि स्थानीय मछुआरों और निवासियों को विश्वास में लिए बिना यह जेटी न बनाएं।

राज्य और शहर कैसे चलता है, वह दिखाओ!

आदित्य ठाकरे ने आरोप लगाया कि पिछले तीन वर्षों में भ्रष्टनाथ शिंदे ने मनपा की ९२,००० करोड़ रुपए की एफडी तुड़वाई। उन्होंने कहा कि जब हमारी सरकार थी, हमने हिंदमाता, गांधी मार्केट, किंग्स सर्कल जैसे वर्षों से जलभराव वाले इलाकों को बाढ़ मुक्त किया था, लेकिन अब फिर वहां पानी भरने लगा है, यह कैसे? उन्होंने कहा कि मुंबई जब डूबती है, तब पालक मंत्री मनपा के ऑफिस में बैठकर तमाशा देखते हैं। ऐसा पहले कभी नहीं हुआ। इसलिए उन्होंने सरकार को सीधा संदेश दिया, राजनीति एक तरफ रखो और जिस पद पर बैठे हो, उसकी जिम्मेदारी निभाओ! राज्य और शहर कैसे चलाया जाता है, वह दिखाओ।

धारावीकरों को क्या मिलेगा?

आदित्य ठाकरे ने कहा कि पुनर्विकास के नाम पर असल में धारावी में क्या होने वाला है, यह सामने आना चाहिए। धारावीकरों को कम से कम ५०० वर्ग फुट का घर मिलना चाहिए। इसके अलावा पुलिस, मनपा कर्मचारियों के लिए कॉलोनी भी बननी चाहिए। इस पुनर्विकास में यहां कुमावाड़ा, कोलीवाड़ा का क्या होगा? लेदर और फूड इंडस्ट्री का क्या होगा? यह सब स्पष्ट किया जाना चाहिए। उन्होंने सरकार से अपील की कि स्थानीय लोगों से संवाद करें।

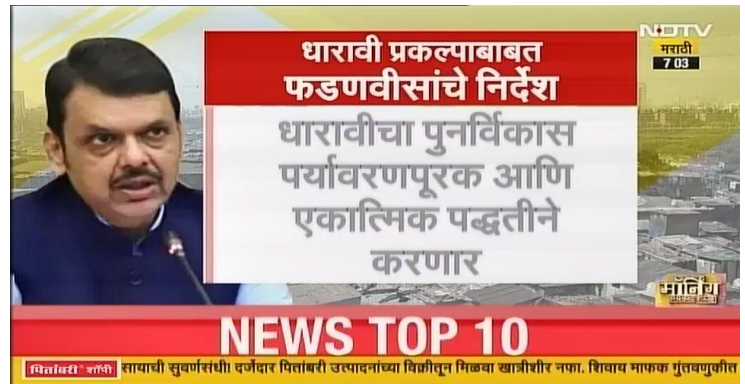
