

Helicopter services have been facilitated, with the government encouraging pilgrims to book tickets only through the official IRCTC website to prevent scams. The main purpose of the scheme is to offer tourists

hygienic, inexpensive, and culturally immersive accommodation prospects while simultaneously generating livelihood options for local citizens. Homestays allow visitors to experience the authentic culture, customs, and food of Uttarakhand, encouraging significant associations with their hosts and the surrounding communities.

The scheme offers significant monetary aid to home owners desiring to transform part of their houses into homestays. In hilly areas, the government provides a capital subsidy of 33% of the project cost or up to Rs 10 lakh, whichever is lower. Further, there is a 50% interest subsidy on loans (up to Rs 1.5 lakh per year) for the first five years. In plain areas, the capital subsidy is 25% or Rs 7.5 lakh (whichever is lower), along with an interest subsidy of up to Rs 1 lakh annually for five years.

Apart from monetary support, the scheme highlights capacity building. The government organises training programmes to help homestay owners develop hospitality and management skills, assuring quality service for visitors and sustainable business practices for hosts.



A midst the serene 250-acre green expanse of Swarn Jayanti Park, which boasts a scenic 10-kilometer walking trail, a quiet wellness revolution has been quietly flourishing since October 2010.

Every morning from 6.30 to 8.30 am, yoga guru and naturopathy expert Rajesh Shrivastava leads two free batches of yoga training, drawing hundreds of participants seeking holistic health.

A diploma holder in yoga and naturopathy and post-graduate in yoga and human medical science, Shrivastava has dedicated his life to promoting yoga as a comprehensive path to physical, mental, and spiritual well-being. "Yoga is not merely a practice; it is a way to unite body, mind and soul," he explains.

Under his stewardship, the Yoga Dharam Sadhana Kendra in Swarn Jayanti Park has become a sanctuary for wellness seekers of all ages. "Our sessions have empowered thousands, helping students unlock their potential, cultivate discipline, and enhance both mental and physical health," Shrivastava said.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, when in-person gatherings were restrict-



ed, Shrivastava swiftly transitioned to online sessions, ensuring continuity in service and community engagement. His commitment remained steadfast despite the challenges.

Shrivastava is particularly focused on stress management, especially for students facing board and competitive examinations. He conducts special summer sessions annually for the students, with this year's scheduled from June 1 to June 15.

His expertise spans Patanjali's Ashtanga Yoga, Yoga Nidra, Vipassana Dhyana, Pranayama, Kriya Yoga, as well as techniques for weight loss and lifestyle disease management. Many participants have reported significant improvements in conditions such as diabetes, hypertension, thyroid disorders and migraines through yoga and diet alone. "Yoga empowers, nourishes, and heals. My mission is to make this ancient gift accessible to everyone," Shrivastava emphasized. Each morning, approximately 80 participants join each of the two one-hour batches.

Recognising the growing community, the Capital Project Administration (CPA), which developed the park, has constructed a dedicated platform and a protective shed for practitioners.

JIVABALASANA

This is a beginner-level standing yoga pose that involves balance and stretching. Similar to Utkatasana, it demands active and strong knees, hence strengthening them. It also strengthens the joints of the hands and feet. It cures rheumatism of the joints. It can be added to Therapeutic Yoga sequences. It activates the twelve secondary chakras within the joints of the hands and feet. These chakras are situated at the ankles, knees, thighbones, wrists, elbows, and shoulders and serve as channels for the vital essence of life force.

STEPS

- Stand in Mountain Pose Variation Feet Hip Wide, shoulder-width apart.
- Inhale, lift your arms, and stretch them parallely in front at shoulder level. The palms are relaxed and facing up, elbows are stretched.
- Exhaling, slightly bend your knees, forming an L-shape. The angle between the thighs and shins is approximately 90 degrees. The back and head are in a straight line.
- Stay here in for about six breaths or as per the body's capacity, Keep your core engaged. Make sure the weight is evenly distributed between the feet. Keep your chest lifted and gaze straight ahead. Maintain steady breaths.
- Yoga teachers can encourage students to cultivate sensitivity and perceive the flow of tellurian energy through the feet that flow upward through the body, nourishing and grounding within.
- To release, straighten your legs as you inhale. Exhale, lower the arms to the sides, and return to Tadasana Variation Feet Hip Wide.
- Finally, relax in Three Part Breath Mountain Pose.
- Tip: Students who find it difficult to balance can follow the same seated on a chair or hovering above a chair.

BENEFITS

- Reduces symptoms related to cold extremities, numbness or tingling and cramping.
- Helps heal wounds, reduces the risk of cardiovascular disease.
- Boosts calorie burn, increases bone density, and improves balance and posture.
- Enhances peripheral circulation and the heart's activity
- Develops strong hips, knees, and ankles joints.
- Targets quadriceps, hamstrings, and gluteus.
- Enhances athletic performance and functional movements like sitting, standing, walking, climbing stairs, bending, and carrying heavy loads
- Incorporated into Power Yoga, and Sculpt Yoga, as Jivabalasana targets the leg muscles, contributing to toning and shaping the thighs and glutes.
- Developing core muscle strength increases workout effectiveness and reduces injury risk.
- Increases your lung capacity.
- Strengthens the torso and lower back while stretching the upper back.
- Regular practise will tone and stabilize your knee and ankle joints.
- Gives a good stretch to the hips, spine, and chest muscles.
- Massages the abdominal organs and stimulates the diaphragm and heart.
- Strengthens immune system and helps to relieve joint pains and back pains.
